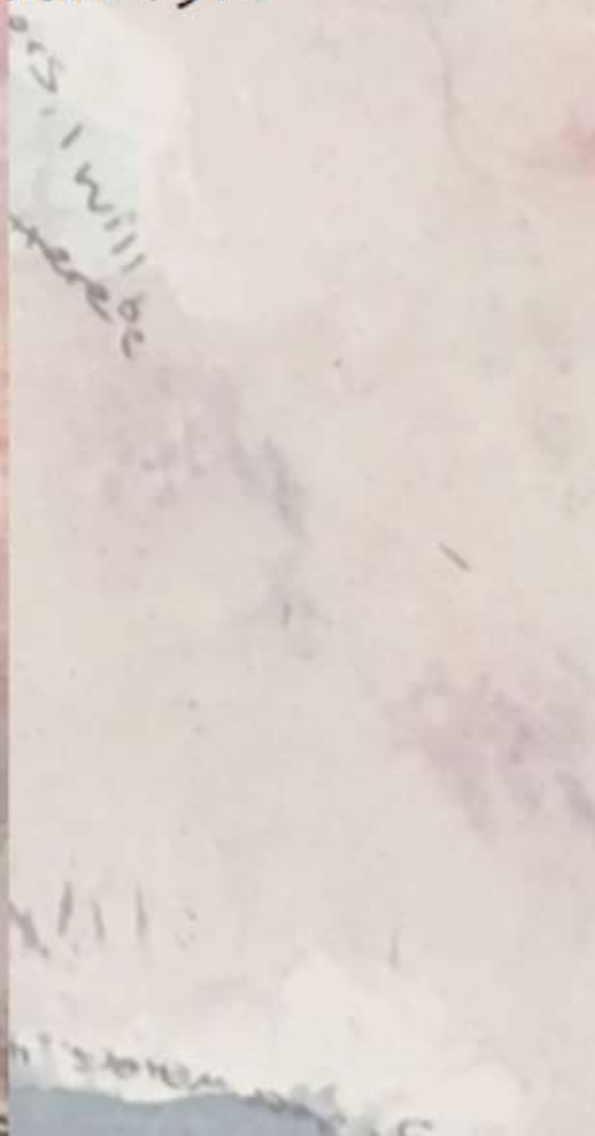


“When you go through deep waters,

Biblical Micrography

Micrography is an art form with Jewish origins that involves the embellishment of biblical texts. Also called 'Micro calligraphy', a minute biblical script is written into abstract patterns or formed into figurative designs such as the shape of animals, flowers or human figures. This creates an interplay between the text and image.

Under the guidance of Daniel Petrie, students and teachers of Broken Bay Diocese have experienced this technique as a meditative engagement with selected Biblical texts that come to life in images inspired by the text.

Daniel's invitation expresses the spirit of the exercise: 'Take a visual pilgrimage across the page as God whispers through the meandering of the pencil or brush in colour.'
